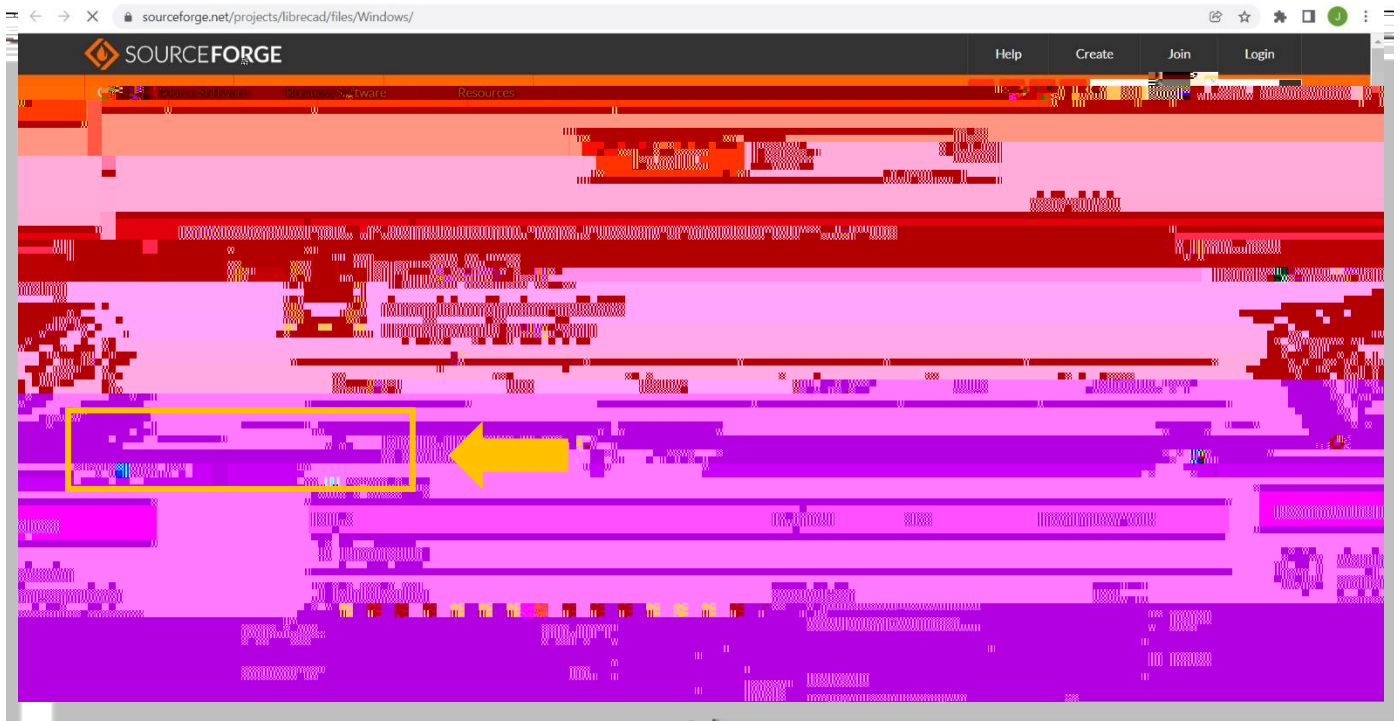
1. Open the LibreCAD website through a web browser (recommend using chrome for this step): <https://librecad.org/>. Click the **Download** link from the top menu bar.



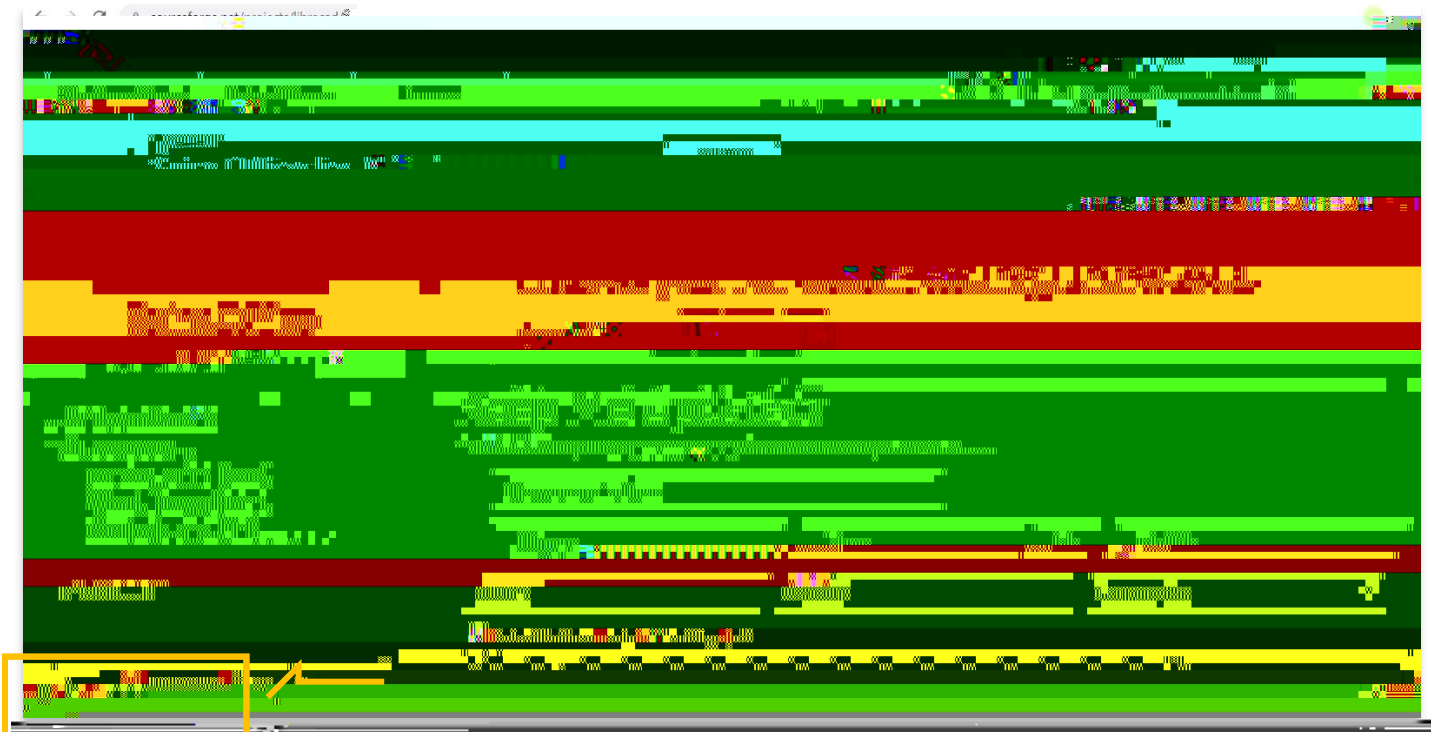
2. Select the from SourceForge link for either PC or Mac.



3. Click the **Download Latest Version** button as show below. The current LibreCAD version during the creation of this tutorial is 2.1.3. There may be a newer version to download during this step. It is recommended to download the newest version of LibreCAD that is stable (not in beta).



4. This will initiate the download of the installer to your computer. You can track the progress of that download in the bottom of your browser. Double click on the file, **LibreCAD-Installer-2.1.3** (or whichever version you have downloaded), at the bottom of your browser to start the installation.



5. Once the installer opens, select **I Agree** after reviewing the License Agreement.

6. The next window allows you to select where to house the program

7. The installation process may take a few minutes to complete. Once finished, select the **Close** button.

8. To check if LibreCAD installed successfully, you can search for the program by typing in "LibreCAD
